LDSS Funding Overview

- ✓ Reimbursable up to £525 per learner for Lead to Succeed, Well-Led and LCIC.
- ✓ Reimbursable up to £135 per learner for Skills for Care CPD modules.
- ✓ Funding available for eligible adult social care employers in England under the ASC LDSS.
- ✓ Employers pay upfront and claim reimbursement via the NHSBSA Digital Claims Service, subject to scheme rules and deadlines.

What You Must Have in Place

- ✓ An up-to-date ASC-WDS account that meets the minimum data requirements set within ASC-WDS.
- ✓ LDSS onboarding completed with NHSBSA so you can access the Digital Claims Service and accept the scheme terms.
- ✓ Pre-course payment made to CareTutor for each learner.
- ✓ Learners who attend all required modules and complete the programme.
- ✓ A claim submitted via the NHSBSA Digital Claims Service within 3 months of course completion, with the required evidence.

Evidence Needed for Claims

- ✓ Providers will usually need to submit:
- ✓ A dated certificate of completion for each learner.
- ✓ The CareTutor invoice showing the course and learner places.
- ✓ Proof of payment, such as a receipt and bank statement or remittance advice clearly showing payer, payee, amount and date.
- ✓ Required learner details in the NHSBSA Digital Claims Service (for example name, job role and workplace details)
