


- Fill in the username with your email address and the password that has been assigned to you.
- On login, you will see the courses that you have completed and the individual courses you have been registered in:




- You can click the status filter on the left side of the page to see either just the courses you have completed, courses in progress or the courses that are outstanding:




- To see outstanding courses, click the “Registered” filter.
- Depending on the way your organisation has assigned you the training, you may also have courses under Curricula or Learning Paths. Click the Curricula tab to see if you have any outstanding courses within the assigned curricula:




- Click on the curricula to see which courses you have outstanding within that:



- If the progress bar on the course is all gray, it means that the course has not been started yet. If the course's progress bar is at 100% and says "Completed" then the course is completed and a certificate will have been generated for you, visible to the admins of your account.
- You can also be assigned training through Learning Paths, where each course will need to be completed in a certain order:



- Here you need to complete the first course before moving on to the second.


- You are also able to change the way you view these courses, through Grid view or List View, and you can change this through the buttons on the top right hand side:




- To start a course, Click the course you want to begin:




- The course will be made up of a few activities, you will need to complete each activity in order:



- Course Content - is the main eLearning course, filled with video training and interactivity
 - Assessment Quiz – is the 15-minute multiple choice assessment you’ll need to complete after the main course content. You will get three attempts at this assessment, and once passed at 80% or higher, a certificate will be generated for you, visible to your training manager.
 - Course Feedback – is your thoughts, comments and feedback on the course
- Once you click on the course you will be taken to the first activity of that course, which will usually be the course content and a “Click to start” button:



- The course will then open for you in a pop-up window. If your browser is not set to enable pop-ups, you can change this through the browser settings – and you can view different ways to do this through this guide: <https://www.wikihow.com/Allow-Pop%E2%80%93ups>



- The course will then give you instructions on how to complete it, through interactivity and video content.
